



### TASTING NOTES:

Wilson & Wilson 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon shows bright, gorgeous colors of pale violet with ruby hues. On the nose, aromas of black fruits, cassis, cherry, and dark red berries are enhanced by pronounced spices of sweet tobacco, anise, licorice and nutmeg. Subtle hints of purple flowers, wet turned earth, cocoa and chocolate round out the aromatics. The palate delivers, concentrated black fruits and brown spices mingled with bitter and milk chocolate, lavender and nuts, culminating in a silky, balanced long finish.

The wine has a firm structure and shows a balance of great acidity with high but firm already integrated fine tannins. Wilson & Wilson is ready to drink today and will age gracefully for 8-12 years in the bottle.
